2014-15 First Face-Off

The Cyclones kick off the season in style with \$1 John Morrell Hot Dogs, Donatos Pizza, & Soda!

Back to Action: The Cyclones open the defense of their Eastern Conference Championship tonight as they kick off the 2014-15 regular season here in Toledo. A year ago, the 'Clones dominated their I-75 rivals - taking seven of the ten meetings and outscoring them by a combined 41-30 margin. Tonight marks the first time since returning to ECHL play that the teams have met to open a campaign.

Scouting the Walleye: Derek Lalonde's embarks on his first season at the helm of the Walleye, who finished in the basement of the Eastern Conference in 2014-15. Most notable among the many new Toledo faces is former Cyclone Anthony Luciani. The fourth-year pro led Cincinnati during the regular season with 53 points (25g, 28a) in 50 games. Walleye team captain, Kyle Rogers, is one of only a handful of Toledo returners. A season ago, the 29-year-old had 34 points in 64 games - the lowest in his ECHL career. Between the pipes, former Michigan State standout Jeff Lerg returns to North America after playing overseas for the last three seasons. In 29 ECHL games with Trenton, he went 13-13-1 with a 3.32 GAA. Fellow netminder Jared Coreau hopes to improve upon a 2013-14 season where he went just 1-12-6 with a 4.03 goals-against average for Toledo.

The New Bench Boss: For the second consecutive year, the Cyclones will open the season with a new face at the helm. On August 12, Matt Macdonald was named the eighth Head Coach in club history, succeeding Ben Simon who accepted a job with the Toronto Marlies. Macdonald is no stranger to the Queen City, having served as the Assistant Coach for the past two seasons along with 119 games as a player in a Cyclones jersey. He was an Assistant Captain on the 2008 Kelly Cup Championship team and has helped lead the club to back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances from behind the bench.

About the Preseason vs. Wheeling: The Cyclones and Nailers split a pair of tilts at WesBanco Arena, both finished as 5-3 decisions. On Friday, October 10, Wheeling rallied from an early third period deficit to claim victory. Then, on Sunday, October 12, Cincinnati returned the favor as five different Cyclones players found the net. Brian Nugent was the star of the weekend, notching three goals in the two games.

More about Coach Macdonald:

Macdonald, a Niagara Falls, Ontario native, makes his Head Coaching debut this season. Since beginning his coaching career in 2012-13, Macdonald has helped contribute to the Cyclones back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances. As a player, he spent parts of three seasons in the Queen City, logging 119 regular season games and 44 points (5 goals, 39 assists). Macdonald also contributed with 14 tallies (5 goals, 9 assists) in 44 Kelly Cup Playoff games and was a member of Cincinnati's first-ever Kelly Cup title in 2008. During that season, he served as an Assistant Captain.

In addition to his ECHL experience, the former defenseman also saw time in the American Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and in Denmark. Collectively, he skated in 385 games as a professional and collected 133 points (30 goals, 103 assists) with 732 career penalty minutes. While playing in Denmark during the 2010-11 campaign, he helped his team capture a Bronze Medal and was a Danish Cup Champion. Prior to going pro, Macdonald was a four-year letter winner at St. Lawrence University, where he amassed 30 points (14 goals, 16 assists) and 131 penalty minutes in 118 career collegiate games.

Macdonald resides in Cincinnati with his wife, Erin, and their one-year-old daughter, Hazel and son, Max.

QUICK HITTERS

The Returners: This year's squad boasts nine players who were a member of last year's Eastern Conference Championship club. Those players are Rob Madore, David MacDonald, Wade Megan, Josh Shalla, Brian Nugent, Chris Reed, Phil Bushbacher, Joe Basaraba, and Andrew Blazek. With the return of David Pacan as well, 10 players on this year's team have seen time for the Cyclones prior to 2014-15.

The Backstops: Both of the Cyclones affiliates have assigned a pair of impressive netminders. Last year's Kelly Cup Playoffs MVP, Rob Madore is back for another season in Cincy - this time as a member of the Milwaukee Admirals organization. The Florida Panthers, meanwhile, have assigned University of Denver standout Sam Brittain to the 'Clones. In college, he posted a 51-34-11 record and was the 2014 NCHC's Goaltender of the Year.

At Home on the Road: One of Cincinnati's biggest strengths from last season will be put to the test right out of the gate - its play on the road. The Cyclones boasted the ECHL's best record away from home last year, going 24-9-1-2. In those games, they outscored opponents by a staggering 96-51 margin.

The New North: With the ECHL absorbing seven teams in early October, the North Division has taken on a new look this season. Cincinnati will now battle the Evansville IceMen, Fort Wayne Komets, Indy Fuel, Kalamazoo Wings, Toledo Walleye and Wheeling Nailers for division supremacy.

Pacman Returns: After a season away from the Queen City, forward David Pacan will don a Cincinnati jersey again this season. In 2012-13, the former Chicago Blackhawks draft pick notched 52 points in 57 games for the 'Clones. He tallied 46 points in 65 tilts with Kalamazoo last year.
