Wing Clipping: After an impressive 4-0 win over Evansville last night, the Cyclones set their sights on another North Division opponent tonight as they welcome in the Kalamazoo Wings for the second time this season. The all-time series has been extremely close between these two long-time rivals, with the Clones owning a 31-25-5-3 record against their Mitten State foes since returning to ECHL play in 2006.

Scouting the Wings: Nick Bootland's club comes in winless in their last three games after last night's 3-1 defeat to the Fort Wayne Komets and now own a 6-5-1-1 record - good for 3rd in the North Division standings. Rookie Curtis Valk has returned from a brief AHL stint and leads the club with 12 points (4g, 8a) in 10 games for the Wings. Defenseman Sacha Guimond is also finding tallies with regularity; he ranks tied for second among all ECHL defensemen with 12 points (1g, 11a) in 13 contests. Joel Martin suffered his fourth consecutive loss to run his 2014-15 record to 5-4-1-1 with a goals-against average of 2.94.

About Last Night vs. Evansville: An excellent performance by Rob Madore and a three-point night from Josh Shalla highlighted a 4-0 win for the Cyclones over the IceMen in front of 2,774 at U.S. Bank Arena. Madore's seventh-career shutout came on a night where he made 24 saves. In addition to Shalla, David MacDonald and Christiaan Minella each contributed with multi-point efforts.

About Tuesday Morning vs. Orlando: Maxime Clermont's 38 saves proved to be just enough as the Solar Bears narrowly defeated the Cyclones by a 5-3 final score in front of 2,936 at U.S. Bank Arena. Wade Megan had a season-high three-point night, including two lamplighters, for his second-straight multi-point game.

About Last Saturday Night vs. Fort Wayne: Former Cyclone Paul Crowder picked up the game-ending goal in the 5th round of the shootout to give the Komets a 5-4 victory over the Cyclones in front of 6,844 at U.S. Bank Arena. Michael Neal enjoyed a season-high two-goal game while Wade Megan and Shayne Taker each collected a pair of assists in the defeat.

More about Coach Macdonald:

Macdonald, a Niagara Falls, Ontario native, makes his Head Coaching debut this season. Since beginning his coaching career in 2012-13, Macdonald has helped contribute to the Cyclones back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances. As a player, he spent parts of three seasons in the Queen City, logging 119 regular season games and 44 points (5 goals, 39 assists). Macdonald also contributed with 14 tallies (5 goals, 9 assists) in 44 Kelly Cup Playoff games and was a member of Cincinnati's first-ever Kelly Cup title in 2008. During that season, he served as an Assistant Captain.

In addition to his ECHL experience, the former defenseman also saw time in the American Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and in Denmark. Collectively, he skated in 385 games as a professional and collected 133 points (30 goals, 103 assists) with 732 career penalty minutes. While playing in Denmark during the 2010-11 campaign, he helped his team capture a Bronze Medal and was a Danish Cup Champion. Prior to going pro, Macdonald was a four-year letter winner at St. Lawrence University, where he amassed 30 points (14 goals, 16 assists) and 131 penalty minutes in 118 career collegiate games.

Macdonald resides in Cincinnati with his wife, Erin, and their one-year-old daughter, Hazel and son, Max.

QUICK HITTERS

Striking First Matters: The Cyclones have found their best success when getting on the board early. They have gone 4-0 when notching the game's opening goal and are 3-0 when leading after 20 minutes.

Middle Period Muster: Cincinnati is cranking up the offense during the second period of games this season. They rank 4th in the ECHL with 15 lamplighters in the middle stanza, outscoring opponents 15-10 during that 20 minute stretch.

Keeping Shots Down: Cincy has been among the league's elite in terms of scoring opportunities against. Coming into today, the Cyclones are allowing the fourth-fewest shots per game on average - just 25.91 per game. In fact, the Florida Everblades are the only Eastern Conference team to have a better average in this department (25.08).

Finding Strides: A couple of Cincinnati forwards are starting to rack up points in a big way. Both Michael Neal and Byron Froese posted two-goal games last Saturday against Fort Wayne. Neal has collected points in three of his last six games while Froese has put his name on the scoresheet in eight of his last nine.

Milestone Watch: Cyclones goaltender, and last year's Kelly Cup Playoffs MVP Rob Madore is approaching a personal milestone. He needs just five more appearances to reach 100 in his professional career. Since turning pro, the University of Vermont alum has posted a 45-36-8 and a 2.80 goals-against average.

Speaking of Milestones: Cyclones forward Michael Neal has also reached a big career benchmark. Last night marked the 300th game of his pro career. Now in his seventh season as a pro, Neal has earned 128 points (54g, 74a).
