Sunday Funday: The Cyclones are back on the home ice this afternoon for a special matinee match-up with the Toledo Walleye. The Fish have taken two of the three meetings between the two clubs this season and, including today, will only face-off four more times all year.

Scouting the Walleye: Derek Lalonde's club has cooled off a bit lately, having lost three of their last four games. However, after last night's 5-2 victory over the Wheeling Nailers, the Walleye sit 14 points ahead of the Cyclones in the North Division standings. Rookie Tyler Barnes leads the "Fish" in scoring with 44 tallies (16g, 28a) in 42 games while Anthony Luciani has been a regular point-getter as well. The former Cyclone has collected 43 points (18g, 25a) in 42 contests. Former Michigan State Spartan Jeff Lerg has been a solid presence in net for Toledo this year, amassing a 20-5-1-1 record and an ECHL 6th-best 2.41 goals-against average. Neil Conway has also done well for his team between the pipes, going 5-2-2-1 with a stingy 2.06 GAA.

About Last Night in Indy: Some early offense and great team defense helped the Cyclones take down the Fuel by a 4-1 final score in front of 5,523 at the Indiana Farmers Coliseum. Stephan Vigier, Chris Reed, and Josh McFadden all registered multi-point games for Cincinnati in the big win.

About Friday Night vs. Indy: Mike Duco scored the game-winning goal on the power play at 2:44 of overtime to lift the Fuel over the Cyclones by a 3-2 final score in front of 6,235 at U.S. Bank Arena. Chris Reed and David Pacan each had a pair of points in the defeat.

About Wednesday Night vs. Reading: A two-point night from Sean Wiles and a 22-save performance from Connor Knapp led the Royals past the Cyclones by a 5-0 final score in front of 2,579 at U.S. Bank Arena. It was Reading's club-record 12th consecutive victory.

More about Coach Macdonald:

Macdonald, a Niagara Falls, Ontario native, makes his Head Coaching debut this season. Since beginning his coaching career in 2012-13, Macdonald has helped contribute to the Cyclones back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances. As a player, he spent parts of three seasons in the Queen City, logging 119 regular season games and 44 points (5 goals, 39 assists). Macdonald also contributed with 14 tallies (5 goals, 9 assists) in 44 Kelly Cup Playoff games and was a member of Cincinnati's first-ever Kelly Cup title in 2008. During that season, he served as an Assistant Captain.

In addition to his ECHL experience, the former defenseman also saw time in the American Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and in Denmark. Collectively, he skated in 385 games as a professional and collected 133 points (30 goals, 103 assists) with 732 career penalty minutes. While playing in Denmark during the 2010-11 campaign, he helped his team capture a Bronze Medal and was a Danish Cup Champion. Prior to going pro, Macdonald was a four-year letter winner at St. Lawrence University, where he amassed 30 points (14 goals, 16 assists) and 131 penalty minutes in 118 career collegiate games.

Macdonald resides in Cincinnati with his wife, Erin, and their one-year-old daughter, Hazel and son, Max.

Shooting Gallery: Cyclones leading scorer Josh Shalla continues to rank among the league's best in shots on goal. So far this season, the Nashville Predators prospect ranks tied for fifth in the ECHL with 162 shots. Shalla has earned 16 goals and 31 assists in 2014-15.

Spreading the Wealth: Unlike some teams around the ECHL, the Cyclones have been an offense-by-committee this year. 13 different players have registered a game-winning goal. Stephan Vigier leads the club in this category with four such lamplighters.

Comeback Clones: While it's not ideal to fall behind on the scoreboard, the Cyclones have done an excellent job in rallying for victory. They have earned 10 comeback wins this season and are on pace to surpass their totals from each of the last six years.

Milestone Achieved: Cincy defenseman Chris Reed skated in his 200th professional game on Wednesday against Reading. The Solon, Ohio native is enjoying a career season with 14 points (7g, 7a) and has tallied nine goals and 40 assists since coming out of Ohio State University in 2011.

Movin' Up the Charts: Cyclones goaltender Rob Madore moved up another rung on the club's all-time games-played charts this week. He now sits in fifth place all-time with 56 games in a Cincinnati jersey and is closing in on Chet Pickard, who played 61 tilts between the pipes.

The Closers: The Cyclones have been extremely efficient when holding the edge after two periods this season. Through 47 games, the Clones have amassed a 16-3-0-1 record when ahead of their opponents through 40 minutes of play.
