Home Sweet Home: After completing their season-long five-game road trip, the Cyclones are finally back on the home ice as they reunite with the Orlando Solar Bears for the last time in 2014-15. Their Sunshine State foes have taken all but one of the get-togethers, and all have been extremely close; all three of their games at Amway Center came down to the wire.

Scouting the Solar Bears: Vince Williams' club earned a point on Wednesday night in Toledo by dropping a shootout decision and now sits just three points out of a playoff spot in the East Division. Jacob Cepis continues to pace Orlando with 48 points (12g, 36a) in 45 games this season while Denver Manderson is close on his heels with 45 tallies (16g, 29a) in 48 contests. Garret Sparks has been the Solar Bears' leading man in net with a 14-6-2-0 and a 2.45 goals-against average. Maxime Clermont, who earned his first shutout of the season on Monday against Cincinnati, is now 7-5-0-2 with a 2.94 GAA.

Macdonald, a Niagara Falls, Ontario native, makes his Head Coaching debut this season. Since beginning his coaching career in 2012-13, Macdonald has helped contribute to the Cyclones back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances. As a player, he spent parts of three seasons in the Queen City, logging 119 regular season games and 44 points (5 goals, 39 assists). Macdonald also contributed with 14 tallies (5 goals, 9 assists) in 44 Kelly Cup Playoff games and was a member of Cincinnati's first-ever Kelly Cup title in 2008. During that season, he served as an Assistant Captain.

In addition to his ECHL experience, the former defenseman also saw time in the American Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and in Denmark. Collectively, he skated in 385 games as a professional and collected 133 points (30 goals, 103 assists) with 732 career penalty minutes. Prior to going pro, Macdonald was a four-year letter winner at St. Lawrence University, where he amassed 30 points (14 goals, 16 assists) and 131 penalty minutes in 118 career collegiate games.

First Cyclones Win: 10/18/14 at Toledo

QUICK HITTERS

Reinforcements from Above: This week the Cyclones received a pair of big defensemen from the AHL. Both Josh McFadden and Garrett Noonan returned from San Antonio and Milwaukee, respectively. McFadden has earned the second most points of any Cincinnati rear guard (15) while Noonan has been a stable hand at the Triple-A level all year long - with nine points and a + 5 rating.

The Closer: Cyclones rookie forward Joe Basaraba has surged to the team lead with five game-winning goals this season. He needs just two more such tallies to tie Josh Shalla's single-season high of seven from the 2012-13 campaign. Basaraba currently ranks second among all ECHL first-year players in that category.

Power Outage: While they have been one of the least-penalized teams in the ECHL this season, Cincinnati has continued to be extremely efficient when faced with a penalty kill. They have allowed just two power play goals in their last nine games - a remarkable 22 of 24 in that span. Overall this season, they have earned an 81.6% kill rate.

Record Setter for Madore: Last week, Cyclones goaltender Rob Madore accomplished something that no other Cincy backstop has since the team returned to ECHL play; he eclipsed the 50 save plateau last Thursday when he finished with 53 against the Solar Bears. On Monday he passed Chet Pickard for fourth on the club's all-time games played list (62).

First Period Tells the Tale: Setting the tempo early into games this season has proved very important for the Cyclones. They are 19-8-1-1 when scoring the game's first goal and are 23-10-1-3 when either leading or being tied after 20 minutes.
