Combing in Points: Cyclones forward Jack Combs has found great success wherever he has been this year. He ranks tied for 4th in the ECHL with 75 points (31g, 44a) in just 46 games. Since joining the Cyclones last week, he's tallied six times (4g, 2a) in four contests.

Notorious VIG: Cincinnati forward Stephan Vigier has seemed to have the magic touch this season. The Cyclones have gone 9-2-0-1 when he lights the lamp and are 15-4-0-3 when he tallies at least a point. He currently ranks sixth on the team with 28 points.
