Cyclones Bobblehead Night

Time for an Overthrow: The Cyclones are back on the home ice tonight as they welcome in the ECHL's hottest team - the Reading Royals. While Reading has claimed both of the previous two regular season match-ups, the all-time series between the pair of non-division foes has been extremely close. Since 2006, the Cyclones own a 35-21-5-4 record against the Royals.

Scouting the Royals: Larry Courville's club had its 14-game point streak snapped last night as they were defeated 4-1 by the Kalamazoo Wings. Pat Mullane leads the Royals, and ranks 11th in the ECHL, with 51 points (20g, 31a) in as-many games this season. Between the pipes, Miami University alum Connor Knapp has led the way with a 17-8-1-0 record and a 2.71 goals-against average. Kenny Reiter, meanwhile, has gone 2-0 in limited action for the Royals with a 3.00 GAA.

About Last Night in Toledo: A pair of second period goals and a strong night for Jeff Lerg proved to be enough as the Walleye defeated the Cyclones by a 3-1 final score in front of 5,536 at Huntington Center. David Pacan netted Cincinnati's lone tally in the final minutes of the contest.

About Wednesday Night vs. Evansville: Some late game offense and a 15-save shutout performance by Sam Brittain led the Cyclones past the IceMen by a 2-0 final score in front of 1,853 at U.S. Bank Arena. It was the third consecutive meeting between the clubs that Cincinnati didn't allow a goal and its sixth shutout of the season overall.

About Last Sunday Afternoon vs. Toledo: Frederick Gaudreau potted the game-winning goal as part of a three-point night to lift the Cyclones over the Walleye by a 3-2 final score in front of 3,153 at U.S. Bank Arena. Cincinnati held Toledo to just 22 shots on goal, the Walleye's lowest total in their last six games.

More about Coach Macdonald:

Macdonald, a Niagara Falls, Ontario native, makes his Head Coaching debut this season. Since beginning his coaching career in 2012-13, Macdonald has helped contribute to the Cyclones back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances. As a player, he spent parts of three seasons in the Queen City, logging 119 regular season games and 44 points (5 goals, 39 assists). Macdonald also contributed with 14 tallies (5 goals, 9 assists) in 44 Kelly Cup Playoff games and was a member of Cincinnati's first-ever Kelly Cup title in 2008. During that season, he served as an Assistant Captain.

In addition to his ECHL experience, the former defenseman also saw time in the American Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and in Denmark. Collectively, he skated in 385 games as a professional and collected 133 points (30 goals, 103 assists) with 732 career penalty minutes. While playing in Denmark during the 2010-11 campaign, he helped his team capture a Bronze Medal and was a Danish Cup Champion. Prior to going pro, Macdonald was a four-year letter winner at St. Lawrence University, where he amassed 30 points (14 goals, 16 assists) and 131 penalty minutes in 118 career collegiate games.

Macdonald resides in Cincinnati with his wife, Erin, and their one-year-old daughter, Hazel and son, Max.

QUICK HITTERS

Shooting Shutdown: Cincinnati continues to stifle teams in the shots on goal department this year. They are allowing an average of 26.2 shots per game, the second-fewest in the entire ECHL. The Clones haven't allowed their opponent to reach the 30-shot plateau in 10 consecutive games.

Career Year: Cyclones defenseman Chris Reed continues to have his best season on his career. He has enjoyed a personal best in goals (7) and remains the second-best scoring rear guard on the Cyclones. Last night, the former Ohio State Buckeye passed Dan Eves for sixth on the club's all-time games played list (197).

The First Tells the Tale: When the Clones have dictated the play in the early-going of games, they have been extremely difficult to beat. When leading or tied after 20 minutes, they are a staggering 21-7-1-2.

Notorious VIG: Cyclones rookie forward Stephan Vigier has been a consistent offensive weapon this season. He leads the club with four game-winning goals and ranks fourth on the team in overall points. More impressively, his game-winning goal totals rank tied for second among all ECHL first-year players.

Playing Nice in the North: Contrary to most years, the North Division holds some of the ECHL's least-penalized teams. The Cyclones rank fifth-lowest in average penalty minutes per game (14.04), while Kalamazoo, Indy, and Toledo all rank in the bottom seven of the league.

One is Good, Two is Better: Getting the game's first goal is always critical. However, it's been even more important for the Clones to jump ahead 2-0 early in games. They are an impressive 17-7-1 when lighting the lamp before their opponent but are a perfect 16-0 when pulling ahead by two.
