Overview: The Cyclones begin the final leg of their western journey on Wednesday in Alaska. Cyclones split their two games over the weekend with the Idaho Steelheads, and still hold down the fourth and final playoff spot in the ECHL's South Division. They currently sit one point back of the Orlando Solar Bears for third, and are one up on South Carolina in fifth.

Saturday Night Recap: The Cincinnati Cyclones (32-26-4-0) fell to the Idaho Steelheads, 5-3, on Saturday night. Forwards Shawn O'Donnell, Nick Huard, and Jordan Sims tallied the goals for the Cyclones. Idaho outshot the Cyclones, 37-35 on the night, with goaltender Joel Rumpel stopping 32 in the loss.

Last Night Recap: The Cincinnati Cyclones (32-25-4-0) picked up a 5-2 win over the Idaho Steelheads on Friday night. Forward Shawn O'Donnell tallied a pair of goals, while forwards Nick Huard, Brandon McNally, and Shane Walsh potted lone markers for the Cyclones, who have now won nine of their last 11 games. The Cyclones were outshot, 35-21 on the night, with goaltender Joel Rumpel stopping 33 to collect his fourth-straight win.

Last Saturday Night Recap: The Cincinnati Cyclones (31-25-4-0) earned a 3-2 win over the Adirondack Thunder on Saturday night. Forwards Jordan Sims and Seth Ambroz, along with defenseman Jonathan Diaby scored the goals for Cincinnati. It was another stellar performance for Cyclones goaltender Joel Rumpel, who turned aside 51 of the 53 shots he faced to collect the win.

Previewing Alaska: The Aces enter Wednesday 4-3-1-0 in their last eight, and are coming off of a 3-2 overtime loss to the Colorado Eagles on Sunday afternoon. Like Cincinnati, the Aces are in a battle for playoff positioning, currently sitting in fourth in the Mountain Division, just four points ahead of Utah. They are led offensively by forward Stephen Perfetto who has accounted for 64 points (27g, 37a) in 48 games played. He is followed by forwards Peter Sivak (32g, 27a), and Tim Coffman (26g, 31a) who round out the top three. In goal, Kevin Carr leads the way with a 16-15-2-2 record, along with a 3.11 goals-against average and a .901 save percentage in 37 games played.

More about Coach Macdonald:

A native of Niagara Falls, ONT, Macdonald is entering his second season behind the bench of the Cyclones. Last season, MacDonald guided the Cyclones to a 31-30-2-9 record a season ago, which was good for fifth place in the North Division, and 10th in the ECHL's Eastern Conference overall.

Since beginning his coaching career in 2012-13, Macdonald has helped contribute to the Cyclones back-to-back Eastern Conference Finals appearances. As a player, he spent parts of three seasons in the Queen City, logging 119 regular season games and 44 points (5 goals, 39 assists). Macdonald also contributed with 14 tallies (5 goals, 9 assists) in 44 Kelly Cup Playoff games and was a member of Cincinnati's first-ever Kelly Cup title in 2008. During that season, he served as an Assistant Captain.

In addition to his ECHL experience, MacDonald also saw time in the American Hockey League, Central Hockey League, and in Denmark. Collectively, he skated in 385 games as a professional and collected 133 points (30 goals, 103 assists) with 732 career penalty minutes. While playing in Denmark during the 2010-11 campaign, he helped his team capture a Bronze Medal and was a Danish Cup Champion. Climbing the Ladder: The Cyclones have won nine of their last 12 games, and are 14-5-0-0 in their last 19 games overall.
